

## **ANTIETAM BLUEBIRD TRAIL WALK**

***Come see the 'Blue and Gray' residents of Antietam National Battlefield in Sharpsburg, MD.***



A Bluebird Trail of monitored nestboxes was established in Antietam National Battlefield Park in 1979 to help these beautiful native birds recover from decades of declining numbers. The trail now boasts 100 paired nestboxes. As of the end of the 2012 nesting season, these boxes had successfully hosted the raising of 8,819 Bluebirds. Our Tour will visit a few of these boxes in this hallowed setting.

The Maryland Bluebird Society invites you to experience this unique view of Maryland's premiere Civil War site.

When: Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Meet at 9:30 AM, Tour will begin at 10am and end at noon
